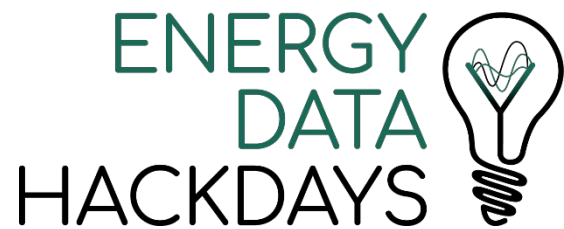


How to submit a Challenge



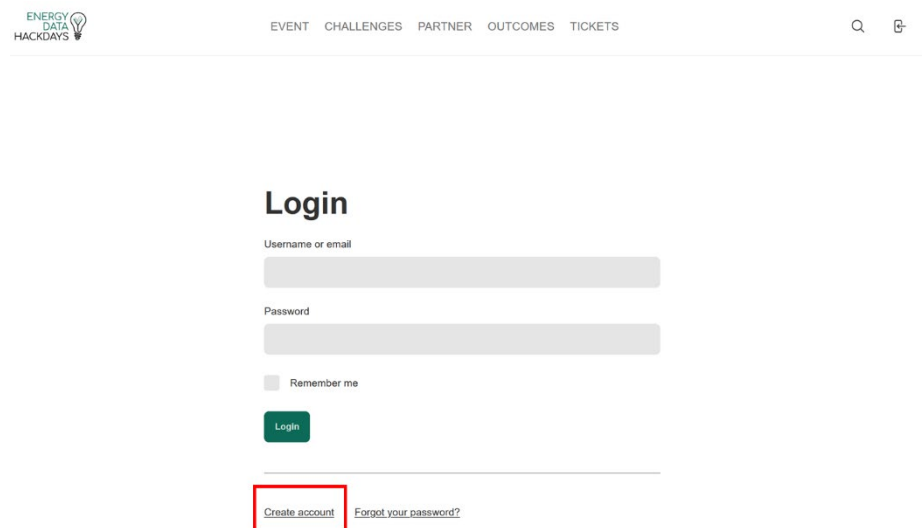
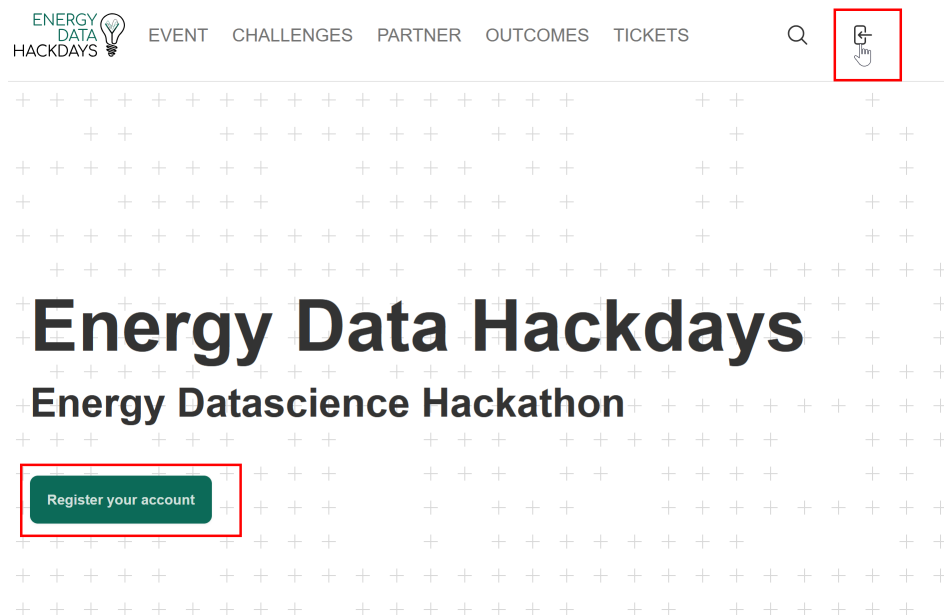
Important note:

We welcome all challenge submissions – whether you're an organization, a startup, a researcher or an individual with a great idea. However, please note that only challenges submitted by official partners or sponsors are guaranteed to be included in the event.

All other proposals will be reviewed and considered, but **we cannot guarantee inclusion** in the final event program.

Step 1 – Create an Account

Go to our website (www.energydatahackdays.ch) and click on the button “Register your account”. Another way is to click on the right Icon in the main menu. You will redirect to the login page. At the bottom you find a link “Create account”



Fill out the fields and click on the button “Register Account”.

Step 1

Submit your challenge

After submission, the organizing team will review and approve it and it will be automatically published on the website.

Step 2

Bookmarking challenges

When published or a little later, fellow Hackers are enabled to bookmark challenges.

Step 3

Day 1 | Morning

Team "placeholders" will be assigned to the challenges. Hackers can then join the teams. No guarantee that a team is formed.

Step 4

Day 1 | Afternoon..

After event opening and short introductions, the final teams are built and hacking starts..

Now add all your information you have from your challenge:

Challenge Name, Short Description, detailed description, and upload files if available.

Once everything has been entered, click on the button "Submit your challenge"

Now we will check your challenge and let you know if it gets approved.

Thank you for successfully submitting a challenge!

Your challenge is now reviewed by the organizing team. If it gets approved, it will be published and appear on the challenges page.

Step 4 – Challenge review status

We will try to give you feedback on your challenges as soon as possible. If the challenge has not yet been released, the status “Challenge is not confirmed yet” (red) is noted. Once we have approved the challenge, we will of course let you know and the status of your challenge will be change to “Challenge confirmed” (green)

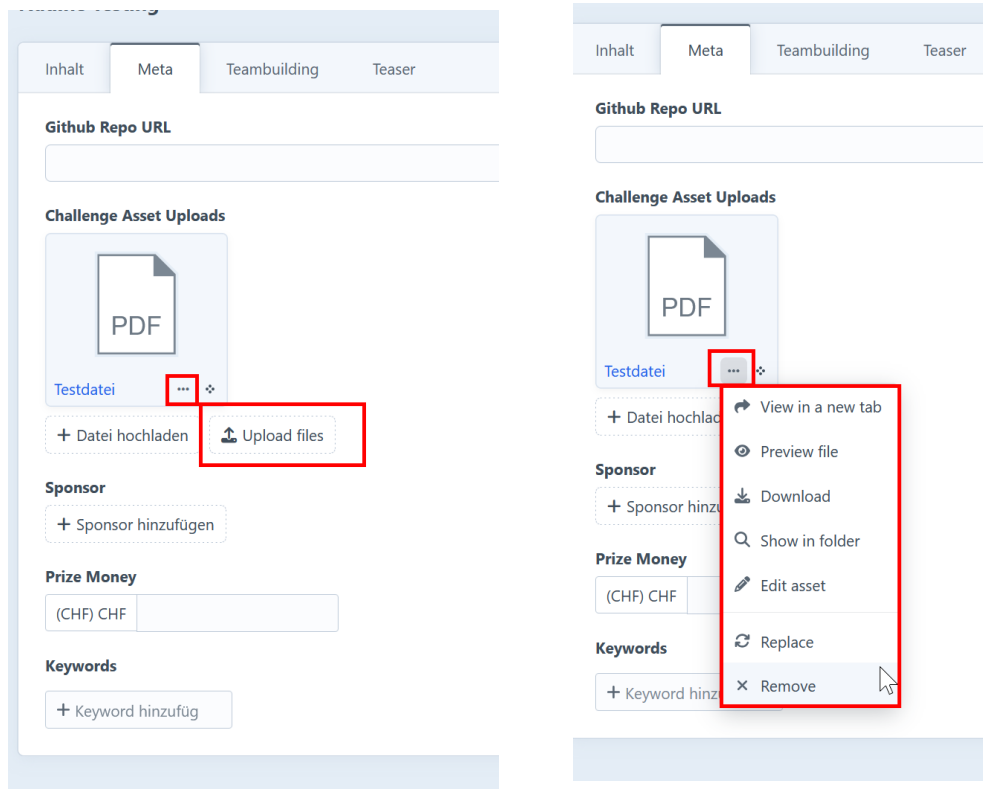
Step 6 – Add or change content of your challenge

To edit, simply click on the appropriate field and you're ready to go.

For uploading or deleting files click on the Tab “Meta”. Now you see an overview of your uploaded files, if you have had uploaded some. Click on the button “Upload Files” to add new files to your challenge.

Existing files can also be overwritten or deleted. Click on the three small dots to open the context menu.



When all changes have been made, click on the red “Save” button at the top right.

To save temporarily, use the key combination Ctrl + s on your keyboard to remain on the page you are currently editing.
